Beckerings Reservoir

This irrigation reservoir was formed from a natural depression in the land, and is situated just one mile north west of Flitwick, Bedfordshire. It is a little over five acres in size, and depths vary widely from approximately 5ft in the margins down to 21ft out in the middle of the lake. As this is an irrigation reservoir the water levels can and do fluctuate.

This well stocked water can produce multiple captures when things go right, even on a short day session. The carp range from 8lb through to 30lb, with the average being roughly 17lb. The margins of the water are very mature with many reed beds, overhanging trees and even a few lily beds, all of which are ideal features to fish beside.

There are 27 swims around the water providing comfortable fishing throughout the year. All tactics work but floater fishing can be particularly productive. There is a secure/gated car-park set well away from the main road, for which you will need a key.

Beckerings Reservoir is a club water which has been run by Luton AC since 1987. Membership to the club costs £48/year and a £20 joining fee applies. Membership also gives you access to several other waters, for full details visit the club website.
